A chestnut horse is red in colour and has a red mane and tail

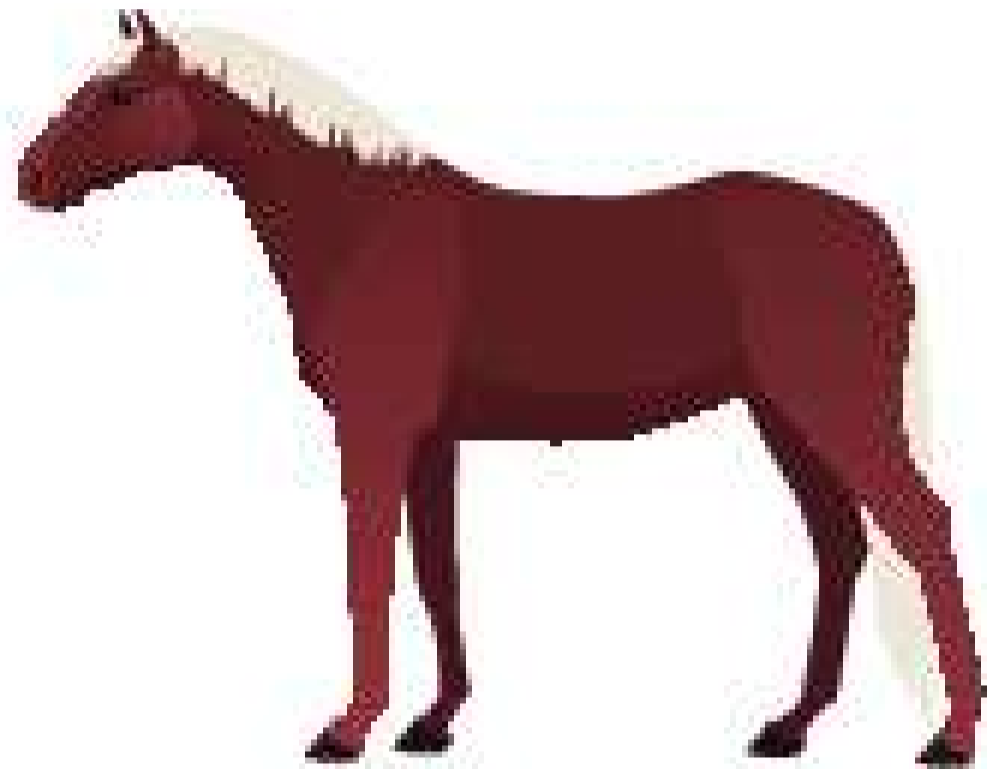
A bay horse is pale brown in colour with a black mane & tail

A black horse is black in colour with a black mane and muzzle

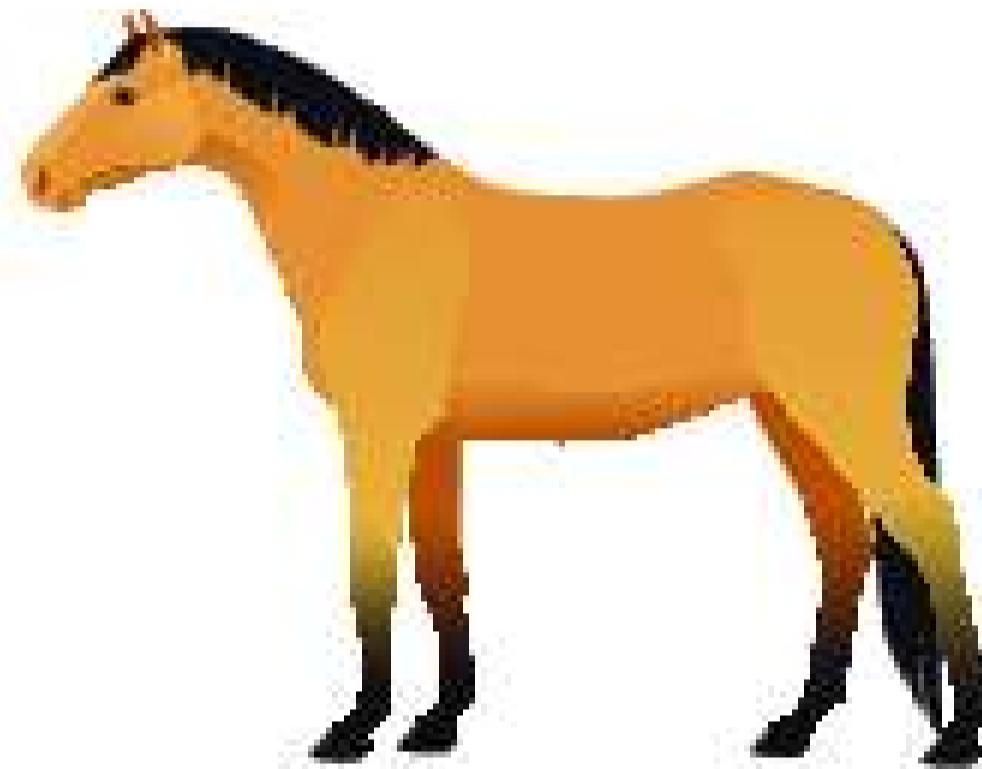

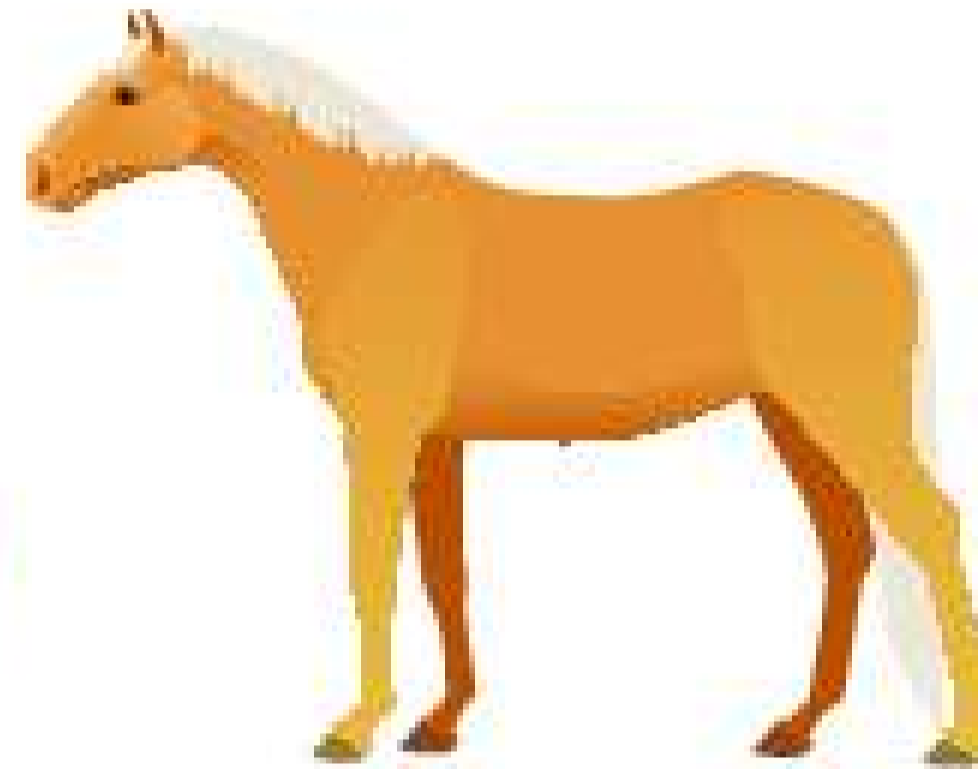

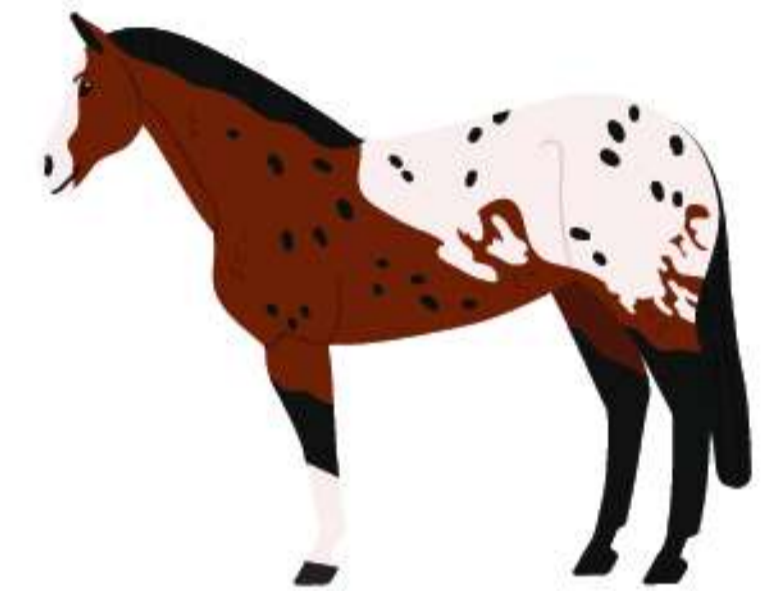

APPALOOSA

A flaxen chestnut horse is red in colour and has a light (flaxen) mane & tail

An appaloosa horse has pink skin and a white or grey coat with darker coloured spots on the coat.

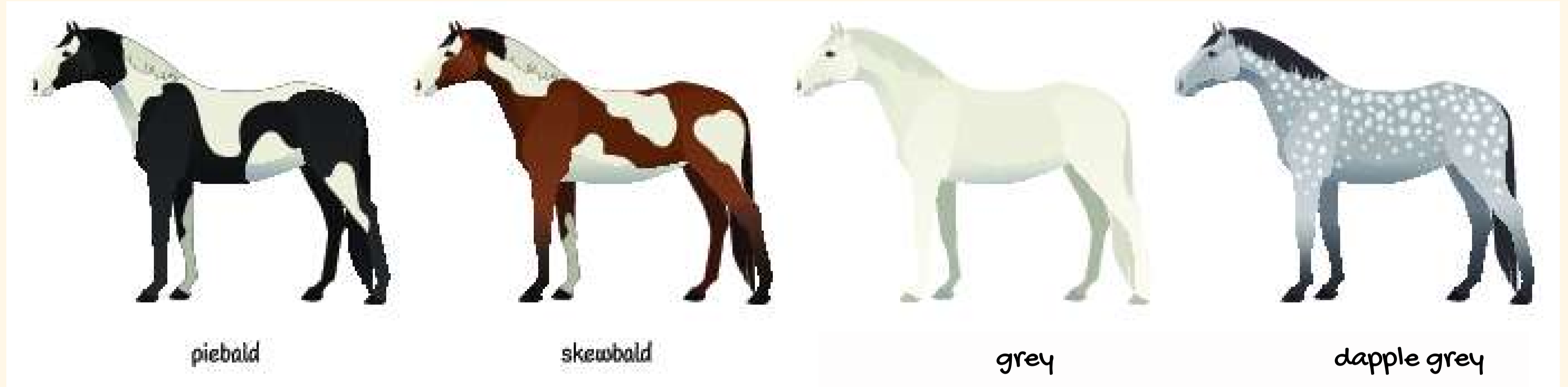
A yellow dun horse is a golden colour with black mane & tail. He may have a dark line along the backbone.

A palomino horse varies from light cream to bright gold with a light or silver mane & tail

A grey horse is white in colour. He has black skin, and there may be black hairs in the coat

A piebald horse is mixture of large, irregular patches of black and white

A skewbald horse is mixture of large, irregular patches of brown and white

A dapple grey horse has circles of black hair over the body

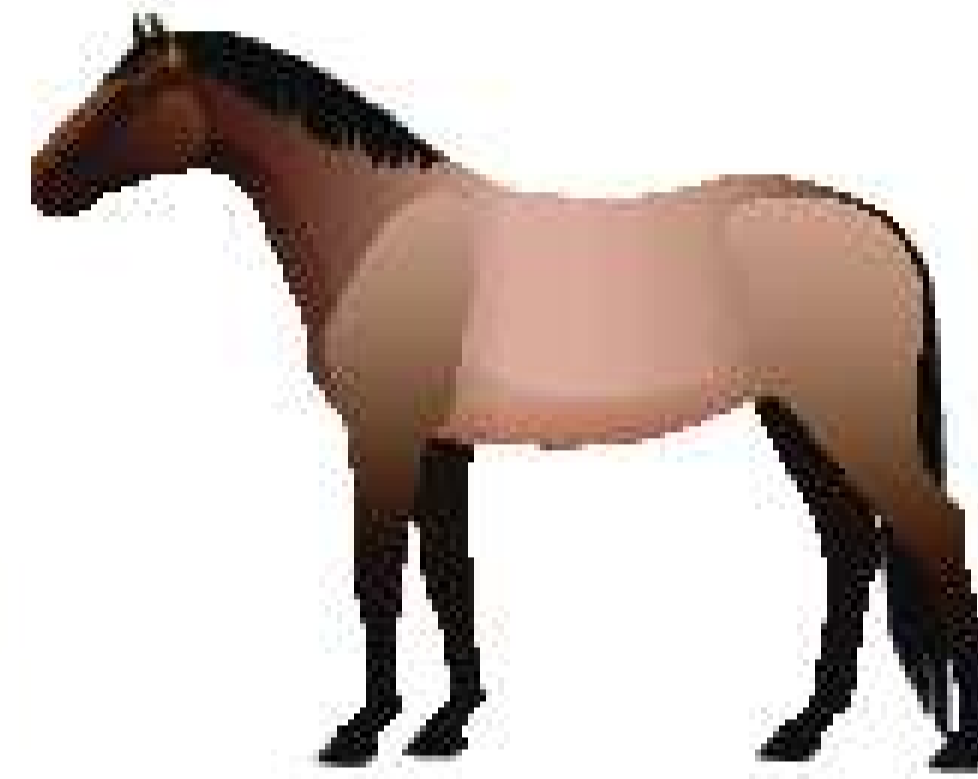

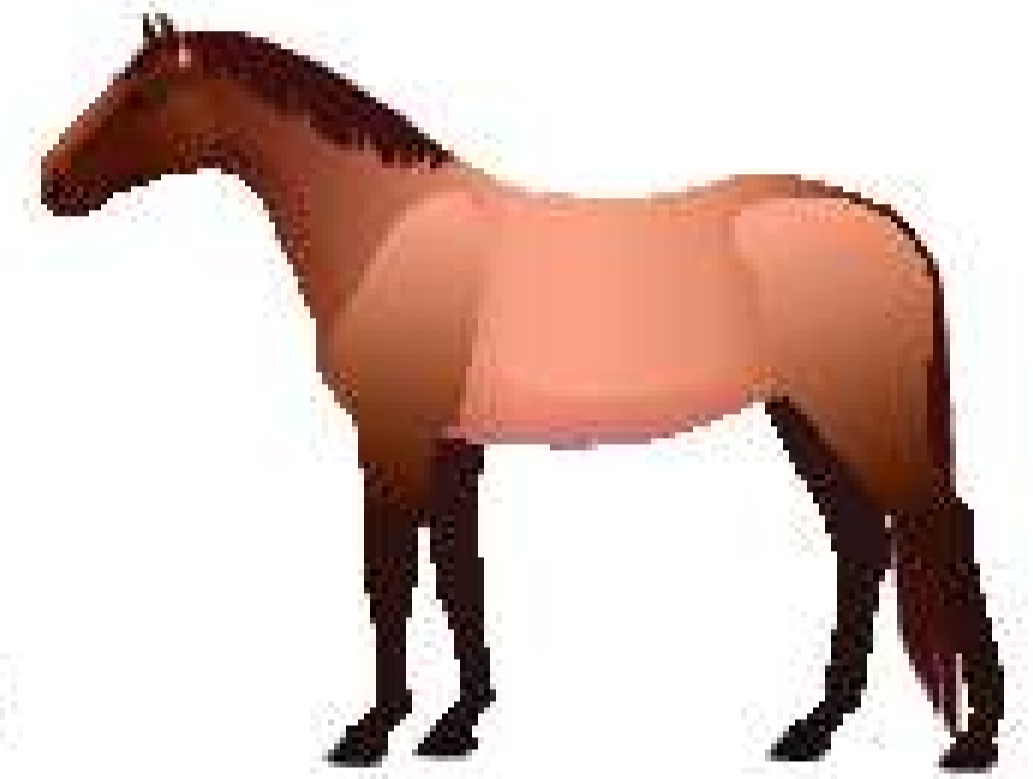
Spotted

A red roan horse is white and chestnut with black mane and tail

A bay roan horse is white and bay (brown) with a black mane & tail

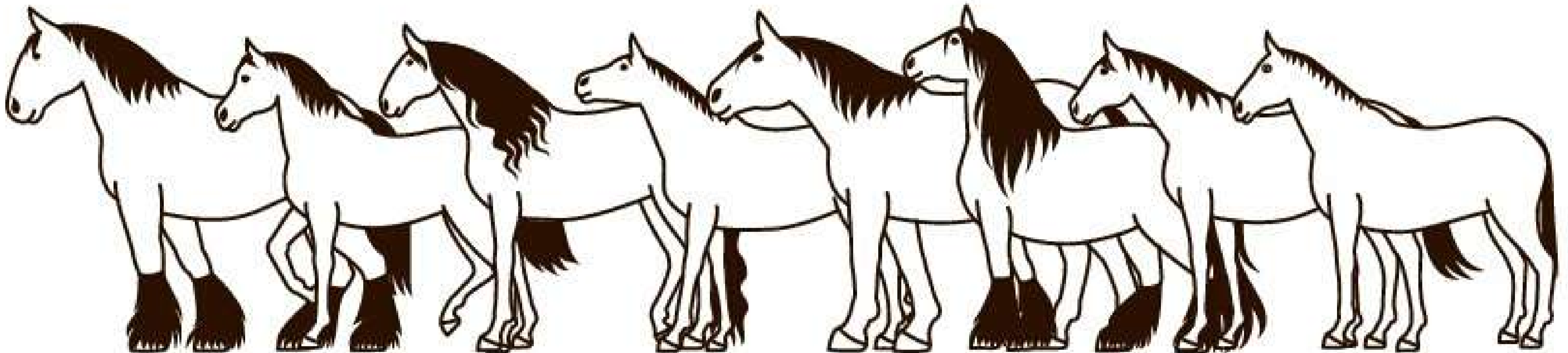
A spotted horse is white with dark spots. These may be leopard spots, blanket or snowflake markings

A blue roan horse is white and black with a black mane and tail, he has a blue tinge.

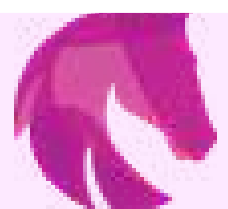


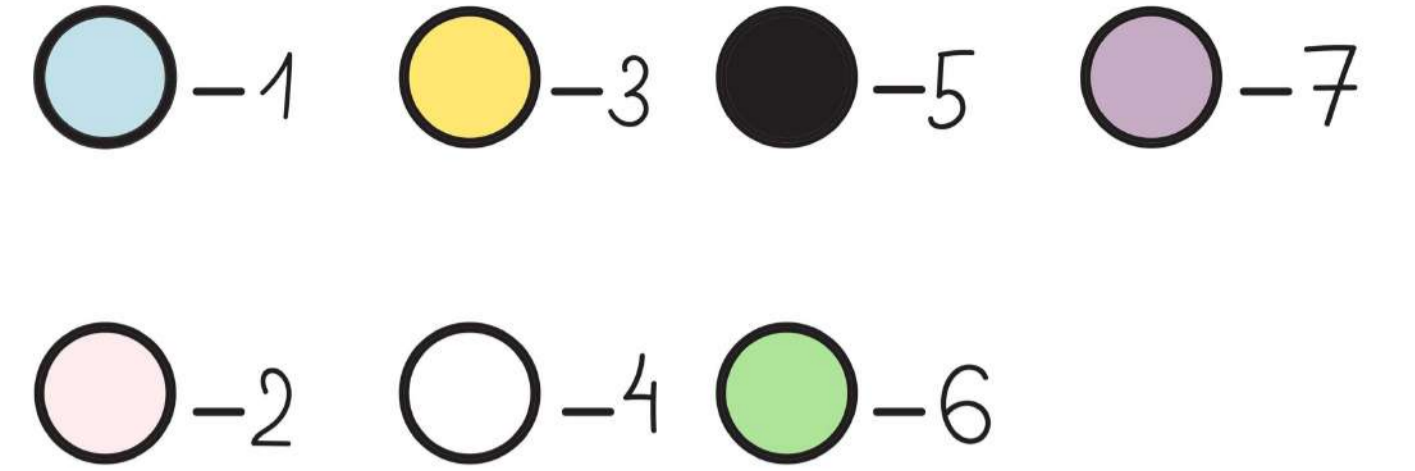
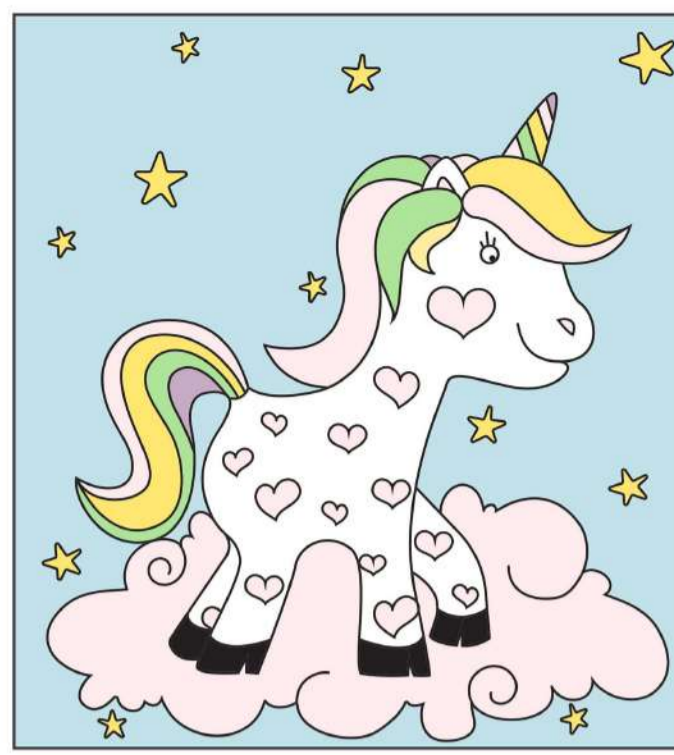

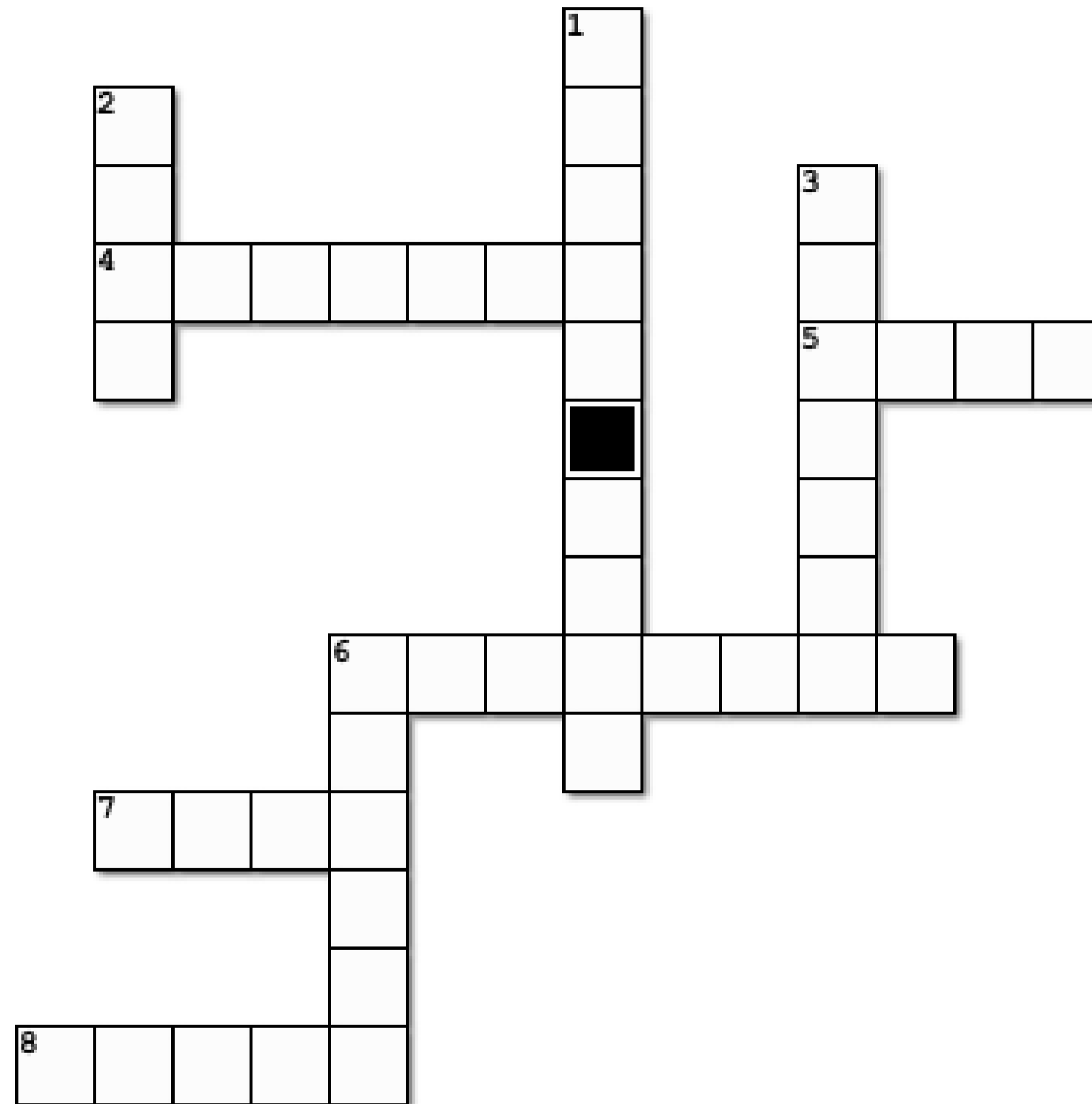

Complete the crossword puzzle below



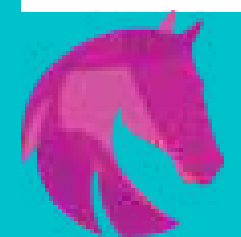

4. A thin marking just above the coronet band
5. A tiny white mark between the nostrils
6. A white marking that extends at least to the bottom of the knee or hock
7. A white mark on the forehead
8. A broad white marking from between the eyes and down the face

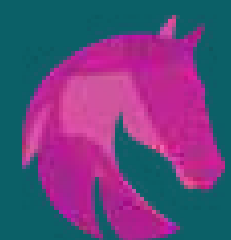
Down

1. A very broad white marking covering the whole of the forehead, the face & down to the mouth
2. A white marking that extends higher than the fetlock but not as high as the knee or hock
3. A marking only on the pastern
6. A narrow white marking down the face
